Chevening Scholarships are awarded to outstanding emerging leaders to pursue a one-year Master's at any UK university. The scholarship programme provides a unique opportunity for future leaders, influencers, and decision-makers from all over the world to develop professionally and academically, network extensively, experience UK culture, and build lasting positive relationships with the UK.

### Entry Requirements:

- Undergraduate degree
- Min 2 years work experience
- Offer letter from the University for the selected programme
- Meet the English language requirements by the end of July

### Application Process:

1. You must have an Offer letter from the University for the selected Programme
2. Submit your application via below website before the deadline
3. Selected candidates will be invited for interview process (February – March)

**Subject Areas:** Any subject area, you can apply for any 3 different courses of your choice

**Scholarship Type:** Full scholarship (cover the full cost of fees and accommodation)

**Application deadline:** August to November (please refer to the website)

## Commonwealth Scholarship



The University of Roehampton participates in the following Commonwealth Scholarships Schemes.

- Commonwealth Master's Scholarship (For candidates nominated by national agencies)
- Commonwealth PhD Scholarship

**Subject Areas:** All subject areas are eligible – although you should note that the selection criteria prioritises applications that demonstrate the strongest relevance to development.

**Scholarship Type:** Full scholarship (cover the full cost of fees and accommodation)

**Application deadline:** November (please contact national agencies)

**Entry Requirements:** Upper second class (2:1) honours

Applications are considered according to the following selection criteria:

- Academic merit of the candidate
- Quality of the plan of study
- Potential impact of the work on the development of the candidate's home country

### Living Off Campus

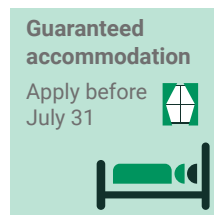
Spring Mews combines stylish ensuite rooms, a social atmosphere and a fantastic location in the heart of the city making it the perfect place to call 'home' while living in London.
