



USA

140+ countries are represented by our international students at Roehampton and London is the most popular study destination in the UK for American students. Each year the university warmly welcomes USA students to bachelors and master's degree programmes.

Most employers in the USA consider degrees earned in the UK to be the same as or better than those earned in the US. Employers are seeking candidates who are well-rounded, with a relevant degree from a reputable university or programme, and they perceive these things to be generally characteristic of Americans who have studied at universities in the UK.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Academic entry requirements

Bachelor's (Undergraduate) Choose ONE of the following:

- High School Diploma minimum GPA 2.8/3.0 + SAT 1100 or ACT 26
Depending on the Subject you are applying for:
*SAT Subject Test with a 550 or higher or 1 AP with a 3 or higher in related subject
- High School Diploma minimum GPA 2.8/3.0 + 2 APs with a score of 3 or above, *1 in related subject
- High School Diploma minimum GPA 2.8/3.0 + ACT score of 26
- International Baccalaureate Diploma is accepted. Point requirements vary according to programme.
- College-level classes/honours classes on a case-by-case basis
- Associate Degree minimum GPA 3.0
- 1 or 2 years of a US Bachelor's degree minimum GPA 2.8

**Only for Sciences, English, Journalism and Digital Media*

Please remember to include any SAT/AP/ACT exam results in your application if you have already taken the tests

Postgraduate (Masters)

- Bachelor's degree minimum GPA 2.8 or 3.0, varies by programme.
- MBA (same as Postgraduate plus a minimum of 2 years professional or managerial work experience)
GMAT is considered, but not required

MBA:

- Ideally three years' managerial or professional work experience, two will be considered
- Academic experience same as taught postgraduate. Graduate Management Aptitude Test (GMAT) of 550 is also considered.

Most popular programmes:

Students study across a range of programmes from Accounting to Zoology – popular programmes include Choreography, Psychology, Human Rights and Primate Biology.

Financial support

USA students studying on undergraduate or postgraduate taught course programmes will benefit from Vice-Chancellor's Scholarships with a maximum award of £1000, we have larger scholarships of up to £6000 pounds detailed on our website. 
Immigration and visa requirements
