


Programme External Examiners and Roehampton Boards Structure

Roehampton University operates a two tier board system and the involvement of programme external examiners is at the first stage of the process – the programme examinations board.

1. Programme Examinations Board

External examiners are members of the programme examination board which oversees the assessment on programme(s) and modules under its purview. The scope of this board is outlined in the diagram below:



2. Awards and Progression Board

The A&P Board has Delegated authority of University Senate on all matters relating to the award of taught undergraduate and postgraduate certificates, diplomas and degrees of the University. Programme-level external examiners are not members of this board, external representation is ensured through an overarching external adviser. The A&P Board:

- 1. Considers recommendations from the Programme Examinations Boards on the academic progress of individual students and to determine the action to be taken in light of this.
- 2. Confers academic awards to eligible students and determines award classifications and fields of study.
- 3. Considers matters referred to it by the University or a Programme Examinations Board.
- 4. Reviews and makes recommendations to University Senate on the academic regulations.
- 5. Reports annually to University Senate.
